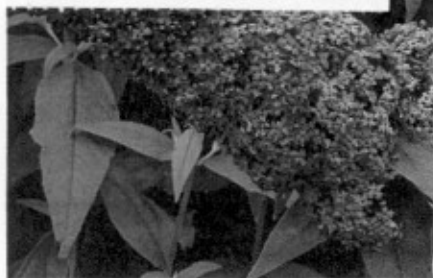

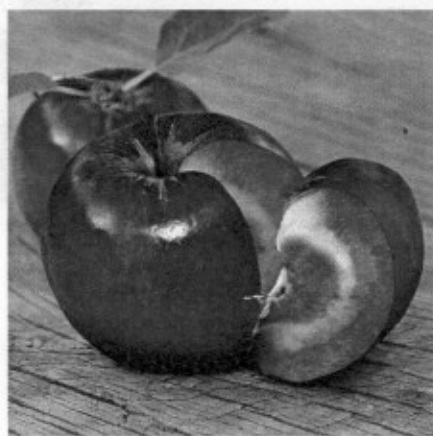
▲ *Buddleja davidii* 'Rêve de Papillon' ('Minpap') has been raised by selection at Minier Nurseries in France. Attractive to butterflies, it produces impressive, large, bright pink flowerheads up to 40cm (16in) and has a neat, compact habit. This cultivar has a particularly long flowering period from July to October making it an excellent summer-flowering shrub. It is available in 3-litre pots from RHS plant centres at £14.99: [www.rhsplants.co.uk](http://www.rhsplants.co.uk)



▲ *Clematis* 'Celebration', launched by Sussex Plants, produces showy, blue-flushed double flowers in May and June, followed by single flowers later in the season. It also has lively, golden leaves and stems with attractive red margins. Enjoying full sun, it can attain a maximum height of 1.8–2.2m (6–7¼ft). 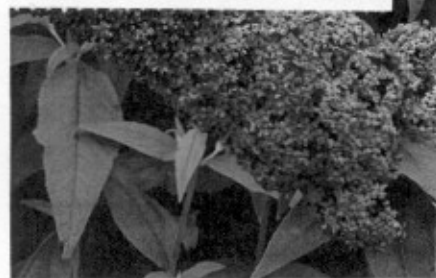


▲ *Helenium* 'Gelbe Waltraut' is a herbaceous perennial, raised by Hartmut Rieger, that reaches 60–80cm (24–32in) and flowers profusely from late June onwards throughout summer. This cultivar produces beautiful flowers with pure yellow ray florets, which surround central, light brown cones. 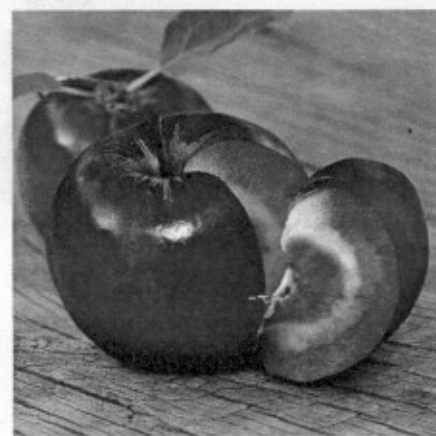
